N&R continue to be busy with work all across the country from Dover to Glasgow. We have demolished concrete plants in Kent and are currently working on a full asphalt plant near Glasgow. We have also been awarded a major contract by **Tarmac** to demolish a full quarry and asphalt plant. This is scheduled to start by the end of the year.

We are also spreading our wings into new sectors and have recently completed the demolition of a small **recycling plant** near Buxton for SUEZ. In turn, this lead on to the award of a large scale recycling plant for SUEZ in Luton, this is to start in early 2025.

I am delighted that levels of enquiries for new work are high and the start to 2025 is looking busy, this is great news as often January and February can be quiet in the demolition world.

Well done to all involved in N&R for a successful 2024 and we hope 2025 will continue in the same way.

#### **Our Next Exhibition**



### Asphalt Plant Refurbishment

As part of a refurbishment project of our customer's asphalt plant in the North East, we recently carried out a number of works including:

- 1. Design, manufacture and installation of new hot elevator casing sections.
- 2. Refurbishment of weigh hopper
- 3. Replacing the worn out reject chute
- 4. Modifying the existing walkway
- 5. Refurbishing the hot storage bins
- 6. Repairing the badly eroded transfer chute





#### **Urgent Screen Refurbishment**

The customer's screen had overtime become badly corroded and was starting to break up. The customer got in touch with us requesting an urgent overhaul of their screen. We collected the screen from the customer's site in West Yorkshire and transported it back to our workshops to carry out the essential repairs. We fabricated two complete new sides as well as carrying out additional repairs as necessary. Once all fabrication works were completed all components were then blasted and painted. All works were completed in 3 days much to the customer's satisfaction.
