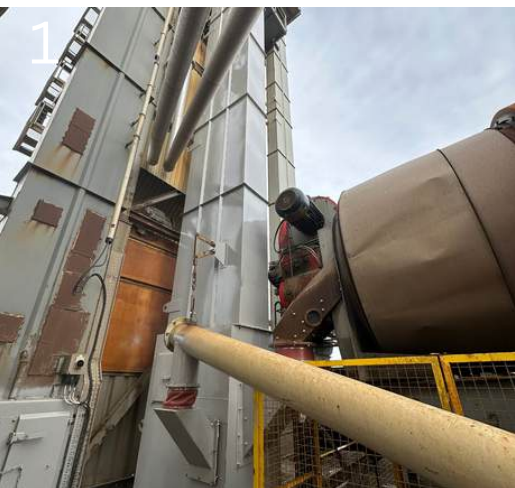

Asphalt Plant Refurbishment

As part of a refurbishment project of our customer's asphalt plant in the North East, we recently carried out a number of works including:

1. Design, manufacture and installation of new hot elevator casing sections.
2. Refurbishment of weigh hopper
3. Replacing the worn out reject chute
4. Modifying the existing walkway
5. Refurbishing the hot storage bins
6. Repairing the badly eroded transfer chute

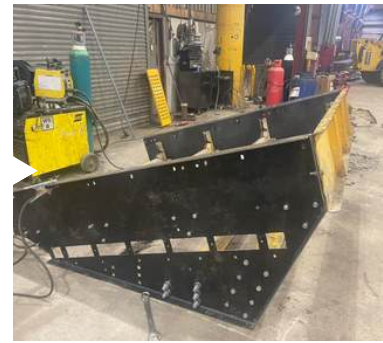

Urgent Screen Refurbishment

The customer's screen had overtime become badly corroded and was starting to break up. The customer got in touch with us requesting an urgent overhaul of their screen. We collected the screen from the customer's site in West Yorkshire and transported it back to our workshops to carry out the essential repairs. We fabricated two complete new sides as well as carrying out additional repairs as necessary. Once all fabrication works were completed all components were then blasted and painted. All works were completed in 3 days much to the customer's satisfaction.
